#### What is Fair Player Club?

In sport games, all players should comply with rules and principles in a 'Fair Play' spirit for fair and just competition. Likewise, in business, all market players should comply with the rule of law in a 'Fair Play' spirit for fair and clean business by promoting anti-corruption, compliance, and business ethics.

Fair Player Club aims to create fair and clean market conditions in South Korea as a public-private platform for anti-corruption by mobilizing the commitments of all market players.

### What is Collective Action?

In collective action, companies work together with each other and with governments and civil society organizations "to create a fair and equal market and to minimize the opportunities for, and risks of, corruption."
